Thank you for considering Arizona Ammunition, Inc. for your ammunition and rifle service needs. We are a new manufacturer and not a reloader. Our ammunition is made rifle and use specific and generally requires that the user provide us with the rifle to test fire. Our focus is on extreme accuracy and performance. We never focus solely on velocity, accuracy is our primary interest.

All ammunition is manufactured with the strictest controls. All powder charges are hand weighed and are within .1 of a grain in accuracy. All bullets are hand seated, all cases are new and are fully "benchrest prepared" for extreme performance. We trim to length, debur the case mouth and flash hole, we recut and square the primer pocket, we straighten the neck and clean. We only use ACCULUBE 10-X bullets and we have our own special chamfer system to reduce the damage to the bullet and removal of the coating upon seating the bullet.

In loading we test every 10th loaded round (or more) for bullet run out to insure that all are straight. Primers are hand seated and rounds are fitted to the rifle and checked in the chamber and box magazine (if any). All ammunition boxes have the customers name, type of rifle, bullet, coating type, and other information on it. Each box is plastic and shrink wrapped for security.

We never offer loading data or advise on loading. We provide ballistic charts with each box and will provide information on the coating and our expected performance of the ammunition and the rifle. We provide advise of the specific use of each bullet.

NOT ALL RIFLES ARE CREATED EQUAL!!

Velocity is unique to each rifle. Many factors effect velocity. Chamber, barrel length, twist rate, barrel condition, bullet weight, temperature, and much more. It is impossible to predict how fast, slow, or accurate a rifle will shoot until the trigger is pulled and data is collected. We offer general ideas on what can be expected, but each is unique! We never guarantee velocity or accuracy in over the counter ammunition.

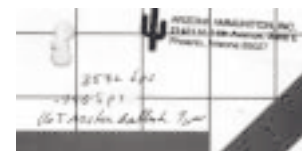

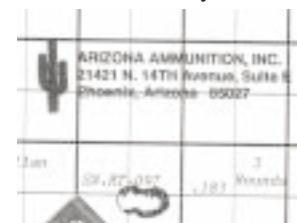

BENCHREST PREPARED CASES

Arizona Ammunition offers a full service and inventory of "benchrest prepared" cases. Our stock inventory is Remington brand cases. In Weatherby we offer the NORMA brand. **All other brands are offered upon request and generally not a problem to do.**

The greatest care is taken in the preparation of a "benchrest prepared" case. We use new cases that are inspected prior to the work. We trim to SAMMI specified length or the customers requested length. the flash hole is deburred, a critical process that will make a great difference in the performance of the ammunition once loaded. We recut and square the primer pocket to insure that the primer seats properly and there is a uniform ignition when the primer is struck. No material is removed from the side of the primer pocket hole.

We debur the flash hole another critical process to insure proper and uniform ignition. We take special care to insure that the deburring process does not go too deep and weaken the case. We use a special inside very low drag chamfer system that reduces the damage to the bullet when seating. It also helps those who use coated bullets because it reduces the removal of the coating upon seating the bullet. This chamfer will give a uniform bullet release for improves accuracy.

Important to the process is the straightening of the case neck to insure proper runout. All cases are full length resized and inspected.

Based on the customers needs, the case necks are turned to a consistent thickness. The purpose of this is to have a uniform or consistent bullet grip and neck tension. This provides for a consistent bullet release. It also helps in tight neck chambers. All work is performed on a lathe with top quality cutting equipment. Each case is measured with a high quality tubing micrometer. Tolerances are held as tight as the quality of the cases will allow.

Finally we put a high polish on each case and then individually box them in a high quality box with the specification of the case preparation on the box label..

On request we will fire form cases for the customer-it is expensive though.

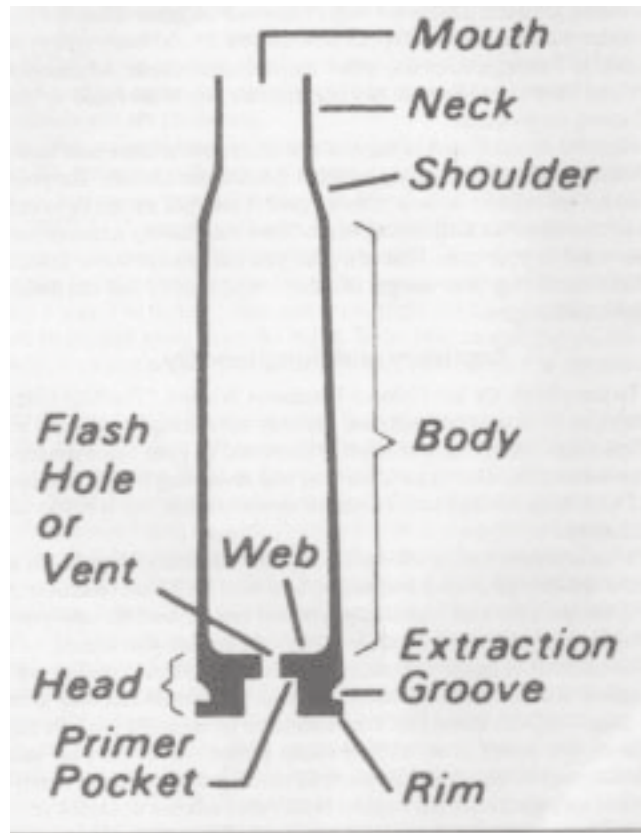
On wildcat cases we will form, anneal, and completely process the case and provide the best custom cases available. This process is slow and very precise, please do not be in a rush when ordering this service. If you do not see what you want, just ask.

Arizona Ammunition, Inc. is the only manufacturer in the world of the famous NECO fire lapping ammunition. This ammunition is intended to help solve accuracy problems in factory and service rifles. Those type rifles that are experiencing extremely poor accuracy in a rifle with a relatively good barrel and action may benefit from this procedure. A rifle that shoots a 5 shot groups of say 3 to 5 inches at 100 yards might benefit from the fire lapping process. Please insure that it is the barrel and not you or the optics that is the problem.

The function of NECO fire lapping is to polish the bore with a series of bullets with different grits on them. The system provides for a specific order of firing of the bullets to achieve this high polish. The results can be a reduction of as much as 200 or 300 percent in group size! Going from a 3 inch group to a 1 inch group is common. It will likely not make a rifle shooting a 1 inch group shoot a 1/4 inch group though.

Please understand that NECO fire lapping accelerates the wear on the barrel by "sanding" it as it polishes the barrel. Custom barrels come hand lapped and it is not necessary nor recommended to use fire lapping ammunition on them. Factory barrels and service rifle barrels can be very rough, even have burrs on them that will effect accuracy. But, the NECO fire lapping process will shorten the life of the barrel by an unknown amount. Of course if the rifle is not shooting well and you are faced with rebarreling, the NECO fire lapping process is a lower cost possible solution.

We do not consider this "new rifle break in ammunition" either. That is not its intent. **We will be offering a new product of "BREAK IN" ammunition for new rifle this year.**

Please think carefully about your application.

NECO fire lapping ammunition is sold in a complete kit of 50 rounds only. We will not break up a full set and do not endorse short cutting the system in any way. We offer no guarantees or warranties on results with the ammunition. Every rifle and barrel is different and reacts accordingly- different. 99% of the rifles that use NECO fire lapping have remarked to us of the improvement in accuracy, ease of cleaning, and over all performance.

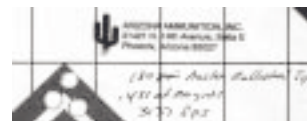

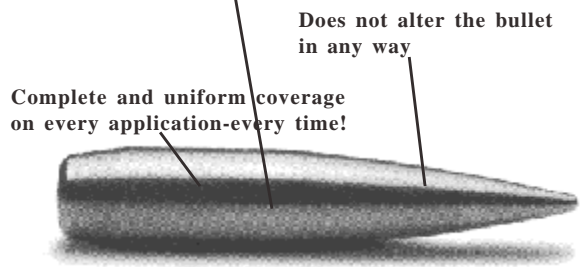
